## SFC suspends Ho Leuk Ming

The Securities and Futures Commission (SFC) has suspended the licence of Mr Ho Leuk Ming for four months from 16 April 2009 to 15 August 2009 (Note 1).

The disciplinary action follows an investigation by the SFC which found that Ho had:

- conducted discretionary trades in his mother's accounts without obtaining written authorisation;
- short sold securities; and
- failed to keep proper audit trail of client order instructions.

Ho's suspension was reduced by one month because he cooperated with the SFC and readily accepted his responsibility for the misconduct.
